



## Alfred Fischer

April 17, 1927 - January 17, 2021

Alfred Fischer, 93, died Sunday, January 17, 2021, peacefully, at his rural Tea, SD, home.

Alfred Ernest Fischer was born on April 17, 1927, on the family farm near Tea, SD, the son of Fred and Aalke (Schoffelman) Fischer. He grew up attending rural school.

On October 3, 1952 he was united in marriage to Lucille Bossman at the Germantown Presbyterian Church parsonage, rural Chancellor, SD. The couple made their home and farmed, on their farm near Tea. Lucille died on February 14, 2007.
