



## Alvin H. Bossman

December 29, 1928 - April 30, 2015

Alvin H. Bossman, 86, of Lennox, SD died Thursday, April 30, 2015, at the Canton-Inwood Hospital. Alvin Harlan Bossman was born on December 29, 1928, on a farm north of Chancellor, SD, the son of Tom and Mattie (Wolthuis) Bossman. He grew up and attended school in the Chancellor, Lennox and Tea areas. Alvin was united in marriage to Lowane Fodness on September 14, 1951. The couple lived briefly in Sioux Falls and Worthing before settling on their home farm southeast of Lennox where they continued to live. Alvin farmed and then became licensed as an electrician. He owned and operated Bossman Electric for the next 38 years. Alvin was an active and faithful member of West Prairie Lutheran Church. He had served on several boards including his rural school board and the Lennox School Board. He was always a fan and player of baseball and softball. In younger years he belonged to the Lennox Browns amateur baseball team. He played men's fast pitch church league softball. He was known by his relatives as a talented barber with hands both strong and gentle. He very much enjoyed dancing with his wife of over 63 years, attending dances weekly. Besides his parents, Alvin was preceded in death by his daughter, Donna in 1993; siblings: Marvin Bossman in 1980, Lucille Fischer in 2007 and Vernon Bossman in 2009.
