At a young age she moved with her family from the farm into town. Ardyce went to grade school in Lennox and often told her children about walking to school and stopping to buy donuts on the way home, her lovely first grade teacher who would change from heels to flats at noon, and a friendly boy who always pushed her on the swing. After high school she taught in a one-room school in the country. She left teaching and married Wayne Dvorak. They had five children together during their thirteen year marriage, Roxy, who passed in 2008, Randy, Tamara, Lori, and an infant who died shortly after birth. She later married Robert Sacre with whom she had a daughter, Heather. Ardyce left South Dakota for California in the 1960s, and spent the next decades raising her children, working, taking part in her church activities, teaching Sunday school, caring for her elderly mother, mother-in-law and disabled sister-in-law, sewing, baking, and enjoying her cats and grandchildren. Ardyce always missed South Dakota, maintaining a subscription to the Lennox Independent and keeping up on hometown news and the news of girlhood friends and their families.
