Arlis Schriever, 90, of Viborg, SD, died Tuesday, October 20, 2020 at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital, Viborg, SD.

Arlis LaVonne Henke was born on June 6, 1930, the daughter of William and Lena (Hyronimus) Henke. She grew up on a farm south of Lennox and attended Sunnyside Rural School. Arlis worked for several families as a nanny and with housework. She also worked at the Sol Bailin General Store in Lennox where she met her future husband, Floyd Schriever.

On November 6, 1956 she was united in marriage to Floyd Schriever, at the Delaware Reformed Church parsonage. The couple lived on a farm south of Lennox. In 1957 they moved to a farm north of Centerville where they started their family, milked cows, fed cattle and raised hogs. In 1973 they bought their current farm northeast of Viborg and continued farming, milking and raising cattle. Husband Floyd, died on September 5, 2018.

Arlis belonged to the Delaware Reformed Church. She loved to cook and was known for her holiday meals, Million Dollar cookies and her pumpkin dessert. She loved flowers, especially the tulips that grew on the farm. She also enjoyed word search puzzles, Bingo and visiting with friends. Most of all, Arlis was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother who deeply loved her family. Besides her parents and husband, Floyd, Arlis was preceded in death by a son Arlen, in infancy; an infant sister and sister, Marceen Svartoi.
