December 20, 1940 - April 15, 2020

Barbara Pederson, 79, of Worthing, SD, died Wednesday, April 15, 2020, at the Avera Dougherty Hospice House, Sioux Falls, SD, following a brief battle with cancer.

Barbara Rose Dubbelde was born, one of 14 children, on December 20, 1940, the daughter of Frank and Eleanor (Bucker) Dubbelde, at Garretson, SD. She grew up in this area attending Sherman rural school and graduating from Garretson High School in 1958, where she had been voted Prom Queen of her senior class.

On November 26, 1960, she was united in marriage to Robert Pederson. The couple made their home in Sioux Falls for 35 years, where Barb worked for the KELO television station for several years, before beginning an over 20 year carrier with the KSFY television station in national account advertising sales. The couple then moved to an acreage near Tea and later into Chancellor. After retiring from her sales job, Barb worked at the Lennox Senior Citizens Center for several years and most recently as a product demonstrator for Costco. Husband, Robert died on October 26, 2015. Barb then moved to Worthing.

Barb was a member of the West Prairie Lutheran Church. She enjoyed sewing and quilting. While living at their acreage near Tea, Barb raised large flower and vegetable gardens, and enjoyed canning the produce she grew. She will also be remembered for being a meticulous house keeper. Most of all, Barb will be remembered for her infectious smile, sense of humor, outgoing

personality and for the love for her family.

Besides her parents and husband Robert, Barbara was preceded in death by two sisters and two brothers.

Grateful for having shared her life are children: Mike (Sheila) Pederson, Beresford and Deb (Mark Reiners) Pederson, Lennox; granddaughter, Ashley (Corey) Hyde, Rapid City and one (almost 2) great-grandchildren; two brothers and seven sisters, as well as a host of other relatives and friends.
