



## Beulah Heiman

June 22, 1912 - September 29, 2011

Beulah Heiman, 99, died Thursday evening, September 29, 2011 at the Lennox Good Samaritan Center. Beulah Alvina Lena (Zorr) Heiman was born June 26, 1912 in Hawarden, Iowa to Emil and Mary (Brinkman) Zorr. She was baptized at her grandparents (Carl and Alvina Brinkman) home in Paulina, IA on September 22, 1912. Beulah received her elementary education, starting in Hawarden, Iowa. Later the family moved to Salem, SD where she graduated from Salem High School. She worked for Central Electric in Salem as a bookkeeper and cashier. She also worked for Sioux Falls Gas. Beulah was confirmed at Zion Lutheran Church in Mitchell, SD May 14, 1950. On November 19, 1950 Beulah was united in marriage to Henry Heiman at St. Martin's Lutheran Church, Alexandria, SD by Rev. Carl Losser, nephew of the groom. After Henry and Beulah were married they lived a few years in Parkston, SD before moving to Mitchell where Beulah worked at Commercial Trust and Savings Bank as a bookkeeper for 20 years. After they retired they worked part-time at Luekens Bakery in Mitchell. Beulah moved to Lennox, SD after Henry's death. She enjoyed making quilts, and made over 100 quilts for World Relief Project for her church. Beulah leaves to mourn her daughter, Marcia (Ronald) Roskeland, Lennox, SD; a granddaughter, Kimberle Roskeland, Sioux Falls, SD; a brother Roy Zorr, Yakima, WA and many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband, Henry (October 4, 1989); her sister, Viola Sieverts and a brother Raymond Zorr.
