Beverly Plucker, 78, of Lennox, SD, died Monday, May 17, 2021 at Ava's House hospice, Sioux Falls, SD.

Beverly Jane Peterson was born on October 9, 1942 in Lincoln County, SD, the daughter of Sidney and Jennie (Wallenstein) Peterson. She grew up in the Lennox and Worthing areas, attending rural school and then graduated from Lennox High School in 1960. She went on to earn a secretarial degree from Nettleton College in Sioux Falls.
