



## Bruce Ingalls

November 7, 1947 - August 22, 2013

Bruce Ingalls, 65, Sioux Falls, died Thursday, August 22, 2013 at the Golden Living Center, Salem, South Dakota from complications of a traumatic brain injury he suffered in 2010. Bruce Edward Ingalls was born on November 7, 1947 at Sioux Falls, South Dakota the son of Dale Eugene and Evelyn Deane (Steever) Ingalls. He grew up in the Lennox area, attending school and graduating from Lennox High School in 1966. He served in the U.S. Navy during the Vietnam Conflict from 1967 to 1968. On May 31, 1975 he was united in marriage to Cheryl Larsen at Our Saviors Lutheran Church, Sioux Falls. The couple lived in Sioux Falls until moving to Hartford in 1982. Four children were born to this union. They were married for 21 years. Bruce moved back to Sioux Falls in 1995. Bruce worked for John Morrell & Company for 20 years in mechanical maintenance. He was a hard working man who often held several jobs. He worked in construction and was gifted mechanically. He enjoyed working on cars and took pride in having restored a 1981 Chevy pickup with his son Jesse. Bruce enjoyed camping, golf, reading and was a huge Denver Bronco fan. He loved vacationing at his family's cabin in Estes Park, CO. Most of all, he loved the time he spent with his children and grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents.
