Clarice Haan, of Lennox, SD, formerly Chancellor, died Saturday, April 9, 2022 at the Avera McKennan Hospital, Sioux Falls, SD.

Clarice Doreen Haan was born August 14, 1933 to Paul and Clara (Ulrikson) Fossum in rural Lennox, SD.

She attended rural school and graduated from Lennox High School in 1951. Following graduation she was employed in the bookkeeping department at the Union Savings Bank in Sioux Falls, SD. It was here that she was introduced to the business world and enjoyed it the rest of her life.

She married her best friend, Fred Haan, on September 19, 1953 at the West Prairie Lutheran Church, rural Lennox, and moved to the family farm northeast of Chancellor, SD, where they worked together in the dairy business. They joined the Lennox Ebenezer Presbyterian Church and remained faithful members there the rest of their lives.
