



## Daniel Meyer

April 22, 1937 - December 6, 2015

Daniel Meyer, 78, died Sunday, December 6, 2015 at the Sanford USD Medical Center, Sioux Falls, SD. Daniel Ray Meyer was born on April 22, 1937, the son of Leo and Lucille (Steffen) Meyer. He grew up near Owanka, SD and graduated from New Underwood High School in 1954. He went on to graduate from SDSU with a degree in Wildlife Conservation and Range Management. He married Bunny Ann King on July 27, 1961 at Stuart, Nebraska. They began their family in Buffalo, SD moving to Martin, SD and Custer, SD. After traveling the U.S. they settled in Lennox, SD. Bunny died on December 16, 2010. . He served in the US Army from November of 1961 until his honorable discharge in August of 1962. He went on to own and operate a flower shop and greenhouse business in Martin, SD for over 15 years with his wife Bunny. He enjoyed hunting, fishing and in later years woodworking.
