Deloris Plucker, Lennox, SD, died Wednesday, June 21, 2017 at the Sanford USD Medical Center. Deloris Arlene Fokken was born on November 9, 1924, on a farm northwest of Chancellor, SD, the daughter of George D. and Myrtle (Stevenson) Fokken. She attended country school, District 4 and graduated from Lennox High School in 1942. On September 18, 1942 she was united in marriage to Arthur Plucker at the Ebenezer Presbyterian Church parsonage by Rev. A.E. Drake. The couple lived on their farm northwest of Chancellor for 64 years moving into Lennox in 2004. Art died on April 2, 2007. Deloris then became a resident of Hilda's Heritage and later the Parker Assisted Living. Deloris was an active and faithful member of Chancellor Reformed Church where she taught Sunday School, RCYF, Bible School, Women's Association and Circle.
