



Dick "Windy Dick" H. Nordmann

August 13, 1914 - October 2, 2014

Dick H. "Windy Dick" Nordmann, 100, died Thursday, October 2, 2014 at the Lennox Good Samaritan Center. Dick H. Nordmann was born on a farm east of Lennox, SD, on August 13, 1914, the son Harm Jr. and Peterka (Bruns) Nordmann. He grew up in this area attending rural school. After school he began work on the family farm until moving to Fargo, ND to work as a mail carrier. He returned to farming after two years, until beginning an over 30 year carrier with John Morrell and Company in Sioux Falls, retiring at age 62. He was a member of First English Lutheran Church.
