Dorothy Myhre, 94, died Sunday, April 12, 2015 at her rural Worthing home. Dorothy Marie Warsing was born to William and Mary (McMahon) Warsing, on April 1, 1921 in Lincoln County, South Dakota, on a farm just $\frac{3}{4}$ of mile from her current home. She grew up here and attended La Valley rural school. She road a horse-drawn carriage to school in Harrisburg, with her future husband, Harold. She graduated from Harrisburg High School in 1938. On October 11, 1940 she married Harold Myhre at Rock Rapids, Iowa. The couple farmed northeast of Worthing. Harold died on December 3, 2009. Dorothy was an active member of the St. Edward's Catholic Church in Worthing. She was the church organist for 73 years. She enjoyed gardening, various types of needle work and was a devoted Minnesota Twins baseball fan.
