Duane Murra, 70, died suddenly Monday morning, August 2, 2010, at his home in Sioux Falls, the result of an apparent heart attack. Duane Verlyn Murra was born in Lincoln County, South Dakota on March 1, 1940, the son of Andrew and Fannie (Bultena) Murra. He attended public school in Worthing and graduated from Worthing High School in 1958. On September 17, 1960 he was married to Beverly Counter. They lived in Lennox and had one son, Todd.
