Duane Woods, 82, of Worthing, SD, passed away January 4, 2023, at the Happy Siesta Healthcare, Remsen, IA, under hospice care.

Duane Wesley Woods was born on October 28, 1940, the son of Marion and Marguerite (Ferrie) Woods, in Sioux Falls, SD.
