



## Effie Wiebesiek

January 22, 1922 - October 1, 2020

Effie Wiebesiek, 98, of Davis, SD, went to her Heavenly home, Thursday, October 1, 2020 at the Pioneer Memorial Nursing Home, Viborg, SD.

Effie Lorraine Poll was born on January 22, 1922, in Turner County, west of Lennox, SD, the daughter of George and Jennie (Korte) Poll. She moved with her family, to Davis in 1937 She attended Ashlong District #89 Rural School and then graduated from Davis High School in 1941. Effie went on to earn her teaching certificate. She taught in rural Turner County schools for seven years.

On August 24, 1947, she was united in marriage to Henry E. "Bud" Wiebesiek. They made their home on a farm north of Davis. On September 15, 1992, Henry died. Effie continued living on the farm for 14 years until moving into Centerville and then Viborg.

Effie was an active and faithful member of the Bethel Reformed Church in Davis where she taught Sunday school and Bible school for many years. She enjoyed working in her garden and in her yard. Most of all she loved spending time with her family.

Besides her parents and husband, Effie was preceded in death by a brother, John in 1987, a brother, Edward in 1967, an infant sister, Martha Marie at age 2 and one grandson, Jonathon McNulty in 2009.
