Elaine Fredricks, 79, of Chancellor, died under hospice care, at the home of her daughter, Carol on Friday, December 14, 2012 in Sioux City, IA. Elaine Carol Klinghagen was born near Tea, SD on March 11, 1933, the daughter of J.H. and Ida (Hoffman) Klinghagen. She grew up and attended school in the Tea area. On November 16, 1949, she was united in marriage to Norman Hugh Fredricks at Luverne, MN. Following their marriage they lived in Kansas City, MO.
