Elvera I. Feekes, 89, of Chancellor, SD, died Sunday, April 17, 2016 at the Pioneer Memorial Nursing Home, Viborg. Elvera I. Miller was born on April 19, 1926, on a farm near Chancellor, SD, the daughter of Elwood G. and Matilda (Krull) Miller. She grew up here attending rural school #90 and graduating from Chancellor High School in 1944. She began work at the Tjaden's General Store in 1950. On December 28, 1952 She was united in marriage to William "Bill" Feekes at Chancellor Reformed Church. Following their marriage they farmed southwest of Chancellor, east of Davis and south of Hurley. In 1961 they moved to Kenosha, Wisconsin. While in Wisconsin, Elvera worked at the Higgins Greenhouse. In 1969 they returned to South Dakota and made their home in Chancellor. She worked in the kitchen of the Chancellor School for 10 years. Bill died on October 23, 2009. In 2009 Elvera moved into Viborg. Elvera was a member of Chancellor Reformed Church and the Chancellor American Legion Auxiliary. She loved to garden, plant flowers and share her produce with others. Elvera was a devoted wife and mother. Besides her husband and parents, Elvera was preceded in death by one sister, Elnora Miller in 2005, daughter-in-law, Cindy Feekes in 2013 and brother-in-law, Raymond Rippentrop.
