Enno "Bummy" Otten, 79, died Monday, May 5, 2014 at the Avera Dougherty Hospice House in Sioux Falls due to cancer. Enno Herman Otten was born at Tea, SD on September 14, 1934, the son of Herman and Clara (Javers) Otten. He grew up and lived in the Tea area, spending part of his growing up years with the Elmore Poppens family. He served in the US Army from 1957 to 1959.
