Esther DeNeui, 93, of Sioux Falls, SD, formerly Chancellor, SD, died Sunday, November 15, 2020, at the Sanford Centennial Hospice Cottage, Sioux Falls. Esther Mayona DeVries was born on December 16, 1926, on a farm near Chancellor, SD, the daughter of William and Flora (Highstreet) DeVries. She grew up here attending rural school.

On December 18, 1948 she was united in marriage to Orrin DeNeui. The couple farmed near Chancellor until 1988, when they moved into Sioux Falls. Orrin died on January 5, 2018, ending a marriage union of over 69 years. Esther was affiliated with and attended Central Church, Sioux Falls. She was a member of the Germantown WIC for many years. She served as a Auxiliary Delegate and volunteer for the Union Gospel Mission. Her greatest joy was her family. Esther was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother who deeply loved her family.
