Eugene "Gene" Buseman, 78, of Chancellor, SD, died Tuesday, September 15, 2020 at Ava's House hospice, Sioux Falls, SD.

Eugene Alan Buseman was born on October 11, 1941, in Sioux Falls, SD, the son of Claus and Tillie (Plucker) Buseman. He grew up and attended rural school near Chancellor and then graduated from Parker High School in 1959. He had worked for at a mink ranch near Tea and a meat packing plant in Sioux Falls before becoming a full time farmer.

On December 14, 1963 he was united in marriage to Wanda Kondert at the First Presbyterian Church in Sioux Falls. The couple made their home in Sioux Falls until moving to their farm near Chancellor in 1972. Wanda died on December 9, 2013.
