Frances Ness, 98, died Sunday, November 22, 2020, at the Centerville Care and Rehab Center, Centerville, SD.

Frances Lucille Kaffar was born on March 8, 1922 at Worthing, SD, the daughter of John and Amelia (Kluin) Kaffar. She grew up here attending school and graduated from Worthing High School. On June 17, 1941 she was united in marriage to Vernon Ness at Luverne, MN. Following their marriage they lived in the Worthing community for most of their married life. Frances worked in food service at the SD School for the Deaf in Sioux Falls. Husband, Vernon died on May 6, 1986.

Frances was a member of St. Edward's Catholic Church in Worthing, where she served on the Altar Society. She also belonged to the Catholic Daughters and had volunteer for the VFW.
