Frances Schriever, 93, died Saturday, April 9, 2011 at the Pioneer Memorial Nursing Home, Viborg. Frances Pauline Simmensen was born on October 23, 1917 at Centerville, SD, the daughter of Soren and Pauline (Rist) Simmensen. She attended Turner County rural school District #58.
