Franklin "Frank" Manges, 83, of Lennox, South Dakota died Thursday, December 6, 2012 at the Lennox Good Samaritan Center. Franklin Leslie Manges was born on March 22, 1929 at Hartford, South Dakota, the son of Leslie Frank and Ethel (Holbrook) Manges. He grew up in this area and graduated from Hartford High School. In 1947 he entered the U.S. Army where he served until his honorable discharge in 1950. He then worked in various jobs doing custom combining, motorcycle repair and as a diesel truck mechanic. He went on to work at the Horner Box Company in Sioux Falls for over 20 years. He had worked in security for Millman Meat Packing and as a diesel mechanic for Peterson Brothers. He also drove taxi cab and helped farm for several area farmers. He drove truck for Johnson Feeds in Fairview retiring in 1990. In 1948 he married Ruth Marie Martin in the state of Kansas. The couple lived in Hartford, Sioux Falls moving to Lennox in 1980. Ruth died on December 3, 1992. In 2002 he married Shirley Donaldson. Shirley died in 2008. Frank was a member of the Lennox Senior Citizens. He played guitar in a local band, entertaining at area nursing homes. In the past Frank repaired and enjoyed riding motorcycles.
