A memorial service will be conducted to honor Fred J. and Margaret E. (Arnold) Meier at the Chancellor Reformed Church on Saturday, June 30, 2012 at 11:00 a.m. A reception will be held at the church following the services. Committal will be at the Chancellor Reformed Cemetery at 1:00 p.m. with military rites by the Chancellor American Legion Post. Margaret was a Sioux Falls native, who graduated from Washington High School. Fred was a native son of Chancellor who met Margaret at Sioux Falls College. They were married in Sioux Falls in 1942 and led an extraordinary life together for the next 64 plus years, until Margaret passed away in 2007. They are returning to their South Dakota roots, having lived in Beresford and Woonsocket until 1952 after Fred's WW II service in the Navy, followed by a short stay in Iowa and finally settling in California in 1956.
