George Albers, 85, died Monday, August 30, 2010 at Sanford/USD Medical Center in Sioux Falls, SD due to complications of Parkinson's Disease.

George was born on October 26, 1924 at Lennox, SD, the son of Louie and Fannie (Bossman) Albers. He attended rural Lennox school and later served in the US Army during World War II. On January 28, 1949 George was united in marriage to Albertha Geiken at Ebenezer Presbyterian Church in Lennox.
