



## Harley "H.P." Nordmann

March 22, 1939 - November 17, 2024

Harley Paul Nordmann (H.P.) passed away the morning of Sunday, November 17, 2024, in Sioux Falls, SD, at the age of 85 years, 8 months, and 5 days. He was born on March 22, 1939, to Harm and Pauline (Ysbrand) Nordmann. He grew up on a farm near Lennox, SD, with his five siblings. He attended Lennox High School and served in the U.S. Navy from 1956-1960. On April 9, 1963, he married the love of his life, Dianne Fae Buus. They moved to a farm near Chancellor, SD, where they spent 61 incredible years together. He was an active member of the Turner County Evangelical Presbyterian Church.
