Harm Wildeboer, 96, of Chancellor, SD passed away quietly at the Tieszen Memorial Home in Marion, SD on December 19th 2015. Harm Wildeboer was born April 21st 1919 on a farm near Lennox, SD to Claus and Effie (Bartels) Wildeboer. Harm was the second oldest of eleven children. Pearl and Harm shared their life together on the farm west of Chancellor until Harm went to the nursing home in January of 2015. Harm was a member of the First Baptist Church, Chancellor, SD where he served as trustee and on the building committee. He served on the Rural District 90 school board. He loved his family, life on the farm, gardening, and reading. In his younger years, Harm loved taking his family on fishing outings, he always knew where the fish were biting. In Harms later years, he enjoyed tending his garden, mowing and riding his golf cart around his acreage and sitting in the warm sun.
