Harold Friese, 80, died Tuesday afternoon, July 20, 2010 at Sanford USD Medical Center, Sioux Falls, SD. Harold Wilmer Friese was born on April 20, 1930 at Monroe, SD, the son of Louis and Etta (Herlyn) Friese. They moved to a farm north of Parker where he attended rural school and then graduated from Chancellor High School in 1948. He served in the US Army during the Korean War.
