Harold Lyle, 86, of Sioux Falls, South Dakota died Friday, July 20, 2012 at the Royal C. Johnson Memorial Veterans Hospital, Sioux Falls. Harold Clarence Lyle was born at Sioux City, Iowa on June 13, 1926 the son of Harold Marshall and Mildred (Brittain) Lyle. He grew up here and graduated from Sioux City East High School.
