Harvey Naatjes, 81, died Sunday, December 19, 2010 at Sanford USD Medical Center in Sioux Falls. Harvey John Naatjes was born on a farm near Lennox, SD on July 3, 1929, the son of George J. and Harmke (Poppens) Naatjes. He attended Crowley rural school and graduated from Lennox High School in 1947. On November 23, 1952 he was united in marriage to Dorothy Witte at Worthing. Following their marriage they farmed near Worthing and moved to their present farm east of Lennox in 1962.
