



Henry "Hank" Ludens

August 18, 1926 - July 24, 2011

Henry "Hank" Ludens, 84, died Sunday, July 24, 2011 at the Lennox Good Samaritan Center, where he had been a resident for three days. Henry R. Ludens was born on August 18, 1926 at White South Dakota, the son of Henry and Rose (Franken) Ludens. He moved to Lennox with his family where he received his education. He served in the US Army during World War II. On August 8, 1950 he was united in marriage to Joanne Uhe at Luverne, Minnesota. Following their marriage they lived in Wisconsin, Iowa and Highmore before moving to the Lennox area. "Hank" was an electrician for many years and was a member of Local #426 Electrical Union for 49 years. His wife, Joanne, died on August 13, 1990. "Hank" continued to make his home in Lennox.
