Inez Muller, 91, died Thursday, July 20, 2017 at the Avera McKennan Hospital, Sioux Falls, SD. Inez Corrine Gedstad was born on May 1, 1926, on a farm southeast of Lennox, the daughter of Arthur and Myrtle (Eichmeier) Gedstad.
