



Jared DeBerg

January 31, 1984 - February 13, 2018

Jared Deberg, 34, died suddenly and unexpectedly, from an apparent heart condition, Tuesday, February 13, 2018 at his Lennox home. Jared Carl DeBerg was born on January 31, 1984, at Worthington, MN, the son of Darwin and Betty (Fricke) DeBerg. He was baptized into the family of God on March 11, 1984. He grew up and attended school in Heron Lake, MN and graduated from Southwest Star Concept High School, Okabena, MN in 2002. He went on to earn a degree in education and social science from the University of Sioux Falls, graduating in 2007, where he met the love of his life, "Dani". On July 15, 2006 he married Danielle Fodness, at home plate of a Sioux Falls Canaries baseball game. They couple lived in Sioux Falls and Lennox before moving to their current home, near Lennox. While in high school, Jared had worked at HyVee and Walmart. He taught middle and high school in Lennox, for one year, before beginning a career at Wells Fargo Bank in Sioux Falls. Here he worked in customer service and loan sales. Recently he was promoted into the IRA Processing department of Wells Fargo. Jared attended West Prairie Lutheran Church. He was a huge sports fan, specifically Minnesota Twin's baseball, but also followed the Minnesota Vikings, Minnesota Wild hockey, Stampede hockey, Pittsburg Penguins hockey, Duke basketball and Sioux Falls Canaries baseball. Jared liked to fish, work in his yard, garden and mow the grass. He was preceded in death by a cousin, Cassidy Voss, grandfathers, Donald DeBerg and Norman Fricke; special grandma, Carol Tomford and uncle Dennis DeBerg. Grateful for having shared his life are his wife, Danielle

and two children, Gretchyn Della, age 4 and Odyn Carl, age 1; parents, Betty and Darvin DeBerg, Heron Lake, MN and parents-in-law, Darwin and Sheree Fodness, Lennox; one sister Lacey DeBerg (fiancé Jordan Hagemann), Brookings; grandparents: Gladys Fricke, Betty (Green) DeBerg and Ray Tomford and numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, aunts, uncles, Godchildren and friends Services will begin at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, February 17 at West Prairie Lutheran Church, rural Lennox with burial in the West Prairie Cemetery.
