



## Jeff Timmerman

May 1, 1965 - August 18, 2018

Jeff Timmerman, 53, of Lennox, SD, died suddenly, Saturday, August 18, 2018 at the Sanford USD Medical Center, Sioux Falls, SD, from an apparent heart attack.

Jeffrey Dean Timmerman was born on May 1, 1965, at Sioux Valley Hospital in Sioux Falls, SD, the son of Harold and Corleen (Skie) Timmerman. He grew up near Lennox, attending Lennox Public Schools and graduated from Lennox High School in 1983. Jeff was an outstanding football player who was part of the Lennox High School State Championship team in 1982. He went on to attend and play football for Sioux Falls College.

On September 23, 1989 he was united in marriage to Denise Story. Jeff worked at Sioux Valley Hospital for a number of years in the patient transport department. He went on to work at John Morrell and Company for 13 years. He worked at several other companies, most recently as a van driver for the Lennox Good Samaritan Center.

Jeff was a member of First English Lutheran Church, Lennox. He was active in Boy Scouts growing up. He enjoyed riding motorcycle and helping with the fall harvest on the Timmerman family farm. Jeff liked watching television, especially NFL football and was a devoted Chicago Bear fan. Most of all he loved his children and family.

He was preceded in death by one daughter, Brittany in 1993 and his grandparents, Alvin and Ardell Timmerman and Helmer and Grace Skie.

Grateful for having shared his life are his four children: Joshua Timmerman,

Brandon, Jacob Timmerman, Lennox, Michaela Timmerman and Isaac Timmerman, both of Brandon; his parents, Harold and Corleen Timmerman, Lennox; two brothers: Steve (Melanie) Timmerman, Brookings and Scott (Dawn) Timmerman, Lennox, as well as nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, other relatives and a host of friends.
