Jeffrey Cain, 71, of Tea, SD, died Wednesday, March 16, 2022 at his home, due to natural causes. Jeffrey James Cain was born on October 24, 1950, at Sioux Falls, SD, the son of Robert and Ruth (McCormick) Cain. He grew up and attended school in Sioux Falls. On July 9, 1970 he entered the U.S. Army, where he served in Vietnam. Jeffrey was honorably discharged on March 2, 1972.

On May 12, 1972 he was united in marriage to Mary Atkins in Tea, SD. The couple made their home in Mitchell, Sioux Falls and Wyoming. Two sons were born to this union. Jeffrey earned an electricians degree from Mitchell Vocational Technical school. He worked as a union electrician as a member of the IBEW. Work took him to the west coast and various other locations in commercial electrical construction. He settled in Tea.

Jeffrey was raised in the United Methodist faith. He was a member of the Lennox American Legion and the Sioux Falls VFW. He enjoyed fishing and deer, elk and antelope hunting. He also enjoyed riding his Harley-Davidson trike. Most of all, he deeply loved his family and the time spent with them.

Jeffrey was preceded in death by his parents and one nephew, 1LT Thomas Martin.
