



## Jerry Jones

March 3, 1960 - March 22, 2018

Jerry Jones, 58, of Lennox, formerly Burke, died March 22, 2018, under hospice care after a life of health issues and a battle with cancer, at his Lennox home.

Jerry Lee Jones was born March 3, 1960 in Burke, SD to Marvin and Inez (Willuweit) Jones. He joined siblings: Kelly and Kathy, twin sister, Jody and later David and Nancy.

He attended the Smith School, Lucus Elementary School and the Burke High School, graduating in 1978. He then attended Mitchell Vo-tech, graduating in 1980 with a diploma in Agricultural Management and returned to the family farm. He helped manage the dairy and sheep operation and raised corn, alfalfa and small grain crops. The farm was what he truly loved, but as health issues came into his life, he returned to Mitchell Vo-tech in 1990 and received and AAS in the accounting/computer program. Jerry returned to Burke where he was hired as the City Finance Officer. Jerry was able to assist in improving the city finances and was also able to assist with various other projects which benefited the community. In 2013 Jerry became the Lennox City Finance Officer. He continued to use his abilities to assist with community projects and improve infrastructure. Jerry was well liked and respected by his coworkers and community members. He was made an Honorary Member of the Lennox Area Ambulance.

Jerry was preceded in death by his father, Marvin, his grandparents and an infant brother, Collin.

Jerry is survived by his mother, Inez, son, Scott, siblings: Kelly (Cindy), Kathy, Jody (Jeff), David (Mary) and of Burke and Nancy (Tom) of Colorado Springs, CO; one granddaughter, Raegan Mary, special friend, Chelsea Fuhrer as well as many nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
