Johanna Plucker, 93, died Thursday, February 3, 2011 at the Tieszen Memorial Nursing Home, Marion, South Dakota. Johanna Peters was born on a farm near Tea, South Dakota on July 2, 1917, the daughter of George T. and Anna (Fischer) Peters. She attended Schoffelman School and grew up there. On March 1, 1937 she was united in marriage to Wessel H. Plucker at Germantown Parsonage, rural Chancellor. They lived on the home farm their entire married life.
