Juanita Nesseim, 83, of Tea, died Monday, April 21, 2014 at the Sanford Foundation Hospice Cottage, Sioux Falls.

Juanita Marie Hilbrands was born at Inwood, IA on February 12, 1931, the daughter of Mike and Cora (Poole) Hilbrands. She grew up in the Lennox/Chancellor area and graduated from Lennox High School in 1949. She went on to graduate from Dakota State Teacher's College in Madison, SD. Juanita taught rural school in Viborg and Lake Preston for several years. On May 19, 1951 she was united in marriage to Robert Nesseim. The couple lived in California while Robert completed his service in the U.S. Navy. The couple returned to Sioux Falls in 1957. They moved into Tea in 1959 and 1966 to their acreage outside of Tea. Juanita loved music and played the organ. She collected dolls and was an avid photographer. She also loved to ride and drive horses and rode in many of the Lennox 4th of July parades.
