Keith Schneiderman, age 81, passed away on July 22, 2023, at the Wakonda Heritage Manor, Wakonda, SD.

Keith Gordon Schneiderman was born April 27, 1942 on a farm south of Lennox, SD, to the late John and Tena (Poppenga) Schneiderman. He grew up here, attending rural school ½ mile from the family farm. He went on to graduate from Lennox High School. Keith then went on to serve in the US Navy, where he was stationed aboard the USS Oriskany from 1963 to 1966, during the Vietnam War. While serving on board this vessel, Keith was injured when he was hit by a helicopter blade on the deck of the ship. After his honorable discharge, he took classes in farming, offered by the US Government. Keith spent the first part of his work life farming. He had been married to Elonda Kuper and to this union one son, John (1976) was born. Later, Keith and family moved to Rapid City where he owned and operated a campground where there were parking places for trailers, RV's and model camp sites. Eventually he returned to live in the Lennox area.

Keith was a proud veteran who belonged to the Sioux Falls VFW and the Lennox American Legion. He enjoyed wintering in California and working on and restoring antique tractors.

Besides his parents, Keith was preceded in death by two brothers: Russell and Merrill.

Grateful for having shared his life are his son, John (Ann Van Ballegooyen) Schneiderman, Davis and sister Bonnie Ohrt, Savage, MN; sisters-in-law,
