



## Kenneth Seeba

February 2, 1928 - January 3, 2012

Kenneth Seeba, 83, died Tuesday afternoon, January 3, 2012 at Sanford USD Medical Center. Kenneth Fredrick Seeba was on February 2, 1928, the son of Harm and Marie Karoline (Fischer) Seeba, on the family farm south of Lennox. He grew up here attending rural school. In 1951 he entered service in the U.S. Army, serving in Korea, until his honorable discharge in 1952. On March 7, 1956 he was united in marriage to Loretta Mae Plucker at Germantown Manse, rural Chancellor. They farmed on the home farm south of Lennox their entire married life. Ken also drove school bus for the Lennox School District for many years. Loretta died on March 7, 2008. Ken was an active member of Delaware Reformed Church and Bertus-Jurgens American Legion Post #283 in Chancellor. He was an accomplished accordion player and played at many events and area nursing homes. He loved to read, travel and spend the winter months in Arizona. Besides his parents and wife, Ken was preceded in death by two infant great-granddaughters, Faith and Hope Heeren and a sister, Henrietta Gedstad.
