Lois Hofer, 94, died Thursday, October 28, 2010 at the Good Samaritan Village in Sioux Falls. Lois Mae Winterboer was born on May 5, 1916 the daughter of Henry C. and Anna (Highstreet) Winterboer. She attended rural school, Chancellor High School and went on to graduate from beauty school. On April 10, 1944 she was united in marriage to Joe Hofer. They lived in Lennox where she owned and operated the Vogue Beauty Salon for over 40 years. Her husband died on November 14, 1976. Lois was a member of First English Lutheran Church and WELCA.
