Lucille Heeren, 89, died Thursday, July 16, 2015 at the Lennox Good Samaritan Center. Lucille Eleanor Heeren was born on October 2 1925, on a farm north of Chancellor, South Dakota, the daughter of Daniel and Wilhelmina (Highstreet) Heeren. She attended rural school District #85 and grew to womanhood there. Lucille lived most of her life on the farm north of Chancellor where she milked cows, gathered eggs, cared for her chickens and had a big garden. She loved flower gardening and taking care of her cats. In later years, she and her sister, Margaret, moved into Chancellor. Lucille was a life long member of Germantown Presbyterian Church. She belonged to the Willing Workers Ladies group at Germantown Church. She was preceded in death by her father in 1937; her mother in 1972; five brothers: Marvin in infancy, Alfred at age 9, Wesley in 1987, Louis in 2002 and Luverne in 2005; her sister Margaret Heeren on December 6, 2011.
