



## Mabel Fischer-Johnson

March 4, 1929 - July 6, 2010

Mabel Fischer-Johnson, 81, died at her home, Tuesday, July 6, 2010. Mabel, daughter of Harry and Jurina (Straat-meyer) Schoffelman, was born on a farm five and a half miles north of Chancellor on March 4, 1929. She attended rural school in Tea and Chancellor. Mabel was married to Johnnie Fischer on July 25, 1952 at her parents home north of Chancellor. They farmed south of Wall Lake until his death of July 26, 1967. She moved into Lennox with her children in November of 1967 and worked as a waitress and a custodian in the Lennox Elementary School, retiring in 1991. She was a member of Germantown Presbyterian Church where she was a Sunday School and Bible School teacher. She had been an E.M.T. with the Lennox Volunteer Ambulance Squad and an assistant Cub Scout leader. She was a member of Lennox American Legion Auxiliary. She married Stanley E. Johnson on August 3, 1985 at West Prairie Church, rural Lennox. They made their home in Lennox. Stan died on March 4, 2000. Besides her two husbands, she was preceded in death by her mother in 1970, her father in 1976, two sisters: Lorene Potratz in 1968 and Edna Steever in 2007; one brother: Oliver Schoffelman in 1993; granddaughter, Jennifer Lynn; great-granddaughter, Sierra Jo, and four infant siblings.
