Mae VanHull, 84, died Wednesday, December 5, 2012 at Avera McKennan Hospital in Sioux Falls. Mae VanHove was born on March 15, 1928 at Chancellor, South Dakota, the daughter of Henry and Annie (DeVries) VanHove. She grew up on a farm near Chancellor and attended country school and Hurley High School, graduating in 1946.
