Margaret Meyer, age 90, passed away, Saturday, December 17, 2022, at Touchmark at All Saints Assisted Living, Sioux Falls, SD, under hospice care. Margaret Lorraine O'Connor was born on January 3, 1932, at Sioux City, IA, the daughter of John Francis Sr. and Violet Sarah (Heiman) O'Connor. She grew up in South Sioux City, NE, graduating from South Sioux City High School in 1953. She went on to earn her Bachelor of Pharmacy degree from the the University of Nebraska. On August 28, 1962, she was united in marriage to Rodney E. Meyer, at Sioux City, IA. Following their marriage, they lived in South Sioux City, NE until moving to Lennox, SD in 1968. Margaret worked as a pharmacist for 45 years, mostly as an owner and operator of the Meyer Drug Store in Lennox. Husband, Rodney died on November 28, 1984. Margaret was an active and faithful member of First English Lutheran Church, Lennox, where she belonged to WELCA. She was a leader in her community and she belonged to and served with the Lennox Senior Citizens, LEE, the Lennox Commercial Club, the Lennox Gold Program, the Lennox 125th Anniversary Committee and the Lennox Library Board. Margaret enjoyed reading and was a devoted Nebraska Cornhusker football fan. Most importantly, she deeply loved her family. Besides her parents and husband, Rod, Margaret was preceded in death by siblings: John O'Connor, Jr, Betty O'Connor, Mary Lederer and Jerry O'Connor.
