Marjorie Clare Lounsbery went to be with her Lord on December 28, 2014 in San Antonio, Texas, one day shy of her 97th birthday. She was born near Burlington, Kansas on December 29, 1917 to Andrew Hayward and Maude (Grimsley) Theobald. She graduated from Strawn Rural High School, Strawn, Kansas and attended Strickler's Business College, Topeka, Kansas. She was employed as a bookkeeper and office manager for General Motors and American Motors Dealerships and retired from Topeka Pump Company, Topeka, Kansas. She was married to Kenneth G.
