



## Merrill Schneiderman

January 31, 1935 - April 17, 2016

Merrill Schneiderman, 81, of Lennox, SD, died Sunday, April 17, 2016 at his rural Lennox home of an apparent heart condition. Merrill Richard Schneiderman was born on January 31, 1935, on a farm east of Lennox, SD, the son of John W. and Tena (Poppenga) Schneiderman. He grew up on a farm south of Lennox attending Sunnyside Rural School. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War from 1954 until his honorable discharge in 1956. On June 3, 1967 he married Gloria Hofer at the Delaware Reformed Church. The couple moved to their home farm south of Lennox, where have since lived. Merrill was a farmer his entire life, but also drove truck for many years. He delivered eggs, hauled milk for Hoelscher Creamery & AMPI, water for Clifford and Phyllis Elcock and drove school bus for the Lennox School District. Merrill was a member of the Delaware Reformed Church and the Lennox American Legion. He enjoyed traveling, coffee at Cenex and Centerville and taking his grandchildren fishing. He was an avid supporter and fan of all of his grandchildren's sporting events and activities. Besides his parents, Merrill was preceded in death by one daughter, Christy Orth on May 28, 2013, and one brother, Russell Schneiderman, on February 22, 2010.
