Myrtle Slaght, 94, of Lennox, SD, died Friday, September 4, 2020 at the Good Samaritan Luther Manor, Sioux Falls, SD.

Myrtle Lyndia Smith was born on Valentine's Day, February 14, 1926 at West Concord, MN, the daughter of Arthur and Albertina (Reider) Smith. She grew up and attended school in this area.
