Nadine Schneiderman, 89, died Monday, April 22, 2013 at Avera Heart Hospital in Sioux Falls. Bernice Nadine McNutt was born on March 9, 1924 in St. Francis, Kansas, the daughter of Russell and Pearl (Voeller) McNutt. She graduated from Saint Francis High School in 1941 and then attended Business College in Denver, Co. On January 3, 1945 she was united in marriage to Harold Schneiderman in Denver, CO. Following their marriage they farmed west of Chancellor and north of Lennox. They lived in Tea for 10 years and Lennox for nine years and then spent 25 years on their farm north of Lennox. In 1995 they moved back to Lennox where she had since lived. Nadine was a member of Second Reformed Church. She had served as sexton on the Lennox Cemetery Board for many years.
